

Inmaculada Riera participates in the preparatory meeting of the Spain-India CEOs Forum

New Delhi, 01/16/2024. - The general director of the Chamber of Spain, **Inmaculada Riera**, participates in India in the preparatory meeting of the Spain-India CEOs Forum, which brings together the main Spanish and Indian companies with the aim of promoting bilateral, commercial and economic relations between both countries.
